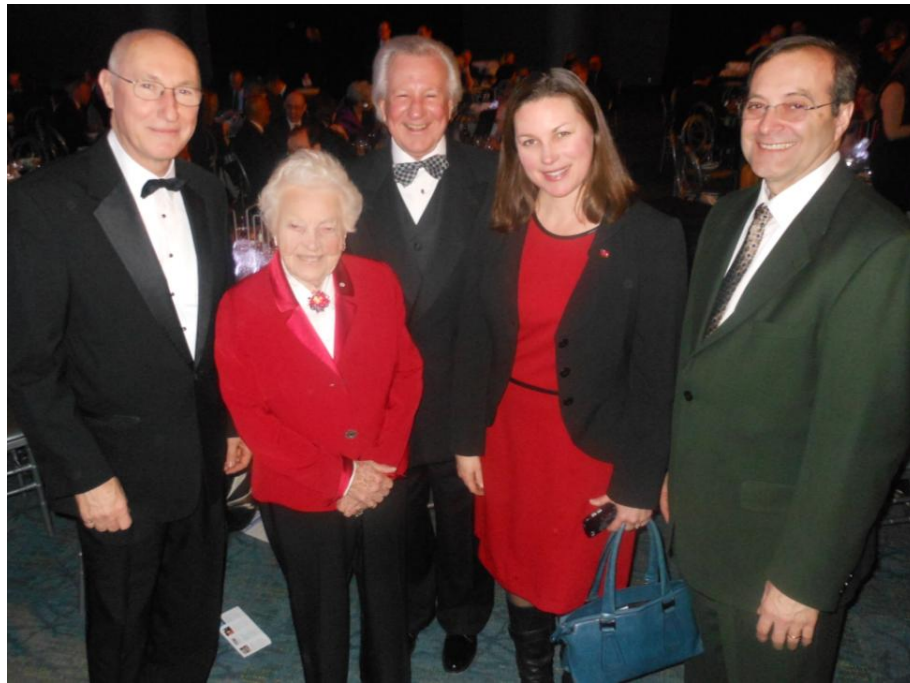

PEO PRESIDENT FEATURED IN TORONTO STAR STORY ON REPEAL

PEO President **Annette Bergeron**, P.Eng., was featured on a 40-paragraph Toronto Star story on January 24. The story, located in the business section, was entitled "Province puts engineering law on the shelf" and outlined PEO's position on the Repeal.

The article said in part: Engineers say that leaving the exception in place is likely to cost lives. And they note that the exception is unique to Ontario.

"We're the only province that has this exception," says Annette Bergeron, president of the Professional Engineers of Ontario. "So why does this province have to have a lower standard of care than the rest of Canada?"

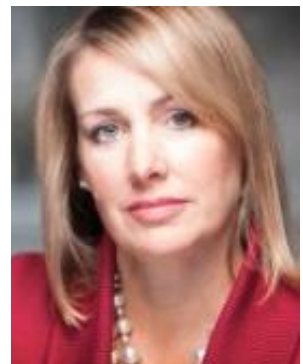
Toronto Star's sister publication, QP Briefing, did a similar story prior to the Government's decision to not proclaim a date for enactment of the legislation. That story was published last May.

It recognizes achievements in politics, business, arts, health care, philanthropy and other fields. The order originated in 1986.

ENGINEERS PARTICIPATE IN BOARD OF TRADE ANNUAL DINNER WITH ONTARIO'S 23RD PREMIER

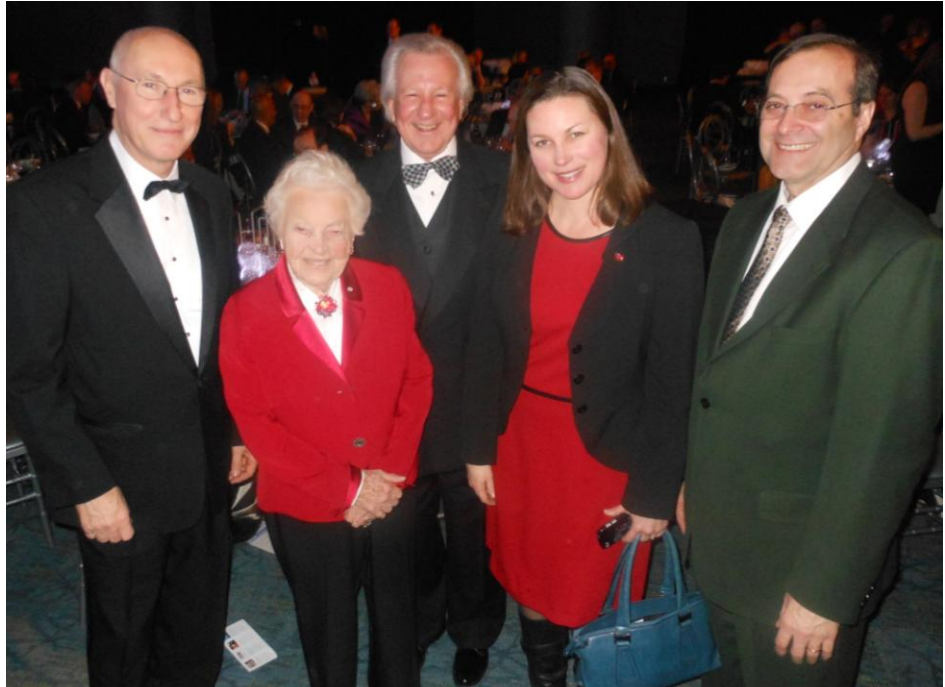
