Given annually to a professional engineer licensed during the year through the association's technical examination program who attained the highest mark in any three technical examination papers, excluding the Complementary Studies and Professional Practice examinations, of those licensed that year by examination.

Isabelle Hemmings, P.Eng., became a member of PEO on April 15, 2016. Holding an undergraduate degree in Mathematics from the University of Waterloo (1996) and

a master's degree in Aerospace Science Engineering from the University of Toronto, Ms. Hemmings successfully completed a total of 10 technical exams with an average of 78 per cent. Her three highest scores were two scores of 89 per cent and one of 85 per cent.

The award honours Professor V.G. Smith, P.Eng., a past member of the former Board of Examiners (now the Academic Requirements Committee).
