2018 AWARDS FOR OUTSTANDING ACHIEVEMENT

THE S.E. WOLFE THESIS AWARD

The S.E. Wolfe Thesis Award is given annually to a member who has passed at least one examination and whose thesis has been awarded the highest mark of all those presented during the year.

Kamlesh Dave, P.Eng., receives the 2018 S.E. Wolfe Thesis Award for his engineer report *Comparison of Experimental Test and Computational Modelling of High Density Polyethelene to Set Reliable Input for Future Finite Element Simulation*. He received a mark of 91 per cent.

THE V.G. SMITH AWARD

The V.G. Smith Award is given annually to a professional engineer licensed during the year through the association's technical examination program who attained the highest mark in any three technical examination papers, excluding the Complementary Studies and Professional Practice examinations, of those licensed that year by examination.

Li Ju Xue, P.Eng., receives the 2018 V.G. Smith Award.
