### **1. Approval of Agenda**

The agenda was approved as presented (Jim/Roger motion)

### **2. Approval of November 10<sup>th</sup> meeting minutes and follow up on action items**

The November 10 minutes were reviewed. It was noted that the last bullet in the section on the PSC discussion should be reworded:

- **CIE will consider whom of its members to recommend to the PSC CIE subcommittee, and that CIE would assist PSC in forming its subcommittee.**

The minutes, as amended, were approved (Jim/Roger motion).

With respect to the follow up from the minutes:

- Use of limited licence – we are still waiting for legal opinion from the new lawyer once they are hired
- ITAC smart grid session – it was determined that no one from CIE was able to attend
- PSC Draft Terms of Reference for practice guideline – George to do this
- CIE Strategy document – Jordan amended the document and posted it in Central Desktop
- ISO 27000 presentation – George has posted the presentation in Central Desktop
- CIE Scopes of Practice re real-time control systems – Jordan has sent to Roger for amendments

- b. Regional Stakeholder Events (Ottawa, GTA, Waterloo); George reported he is still trying to arrange these
