ENGINEER PARTICIPATES IN FINANCE MINISTER UPDATE ON BUDGET

Finance Minister Vic Fedeli MPP (PC—Nipissing) addressed a gathering of about 750 people at the Empire Club in Toronto on March 28. Minister Fedeli outlined his plans for the upcoming budget on April 11. He spoke extensively of his desire to address the provincial debt. There is much speculation that any expected cuts could impact many provincial programs.

Attending the event were **Darryl Spector**, P.Eng., President of Promotion Nuclear, **Sandro Perruzza**, Chief Executive Officer of Ontario Society of Professional Engineers (OSPE) and PEO Government Relations Consultant **Howard Brown**. Mr. Brown had a chance to speak with the finance minister afterwards. Minister Fedeli told Mr. Brown that he appreciated the good work PEO did working with MPPs. He acknowledged the excellent relationship PC caucus developed with PEO even when they were in opposition.

Mr. Fedeli spoke at the Northern Region GLP Academy in North Bay in January.


Both Ontario Society of Professional Engineers and Engineers Canada are being given the opportunity to do short presentations at the AGM.
