## INTERNATIONAL ADVISOR HEADING PEO REVIEW SPEAKS WITH PEO COUNCIL



International advisor, Harry Cayton, addressed PEO Council on February 8 at PEO Headquarters.

PEO Council held its 524th Council meeting on February 7 and 8 at PEO Headquarters.

PEO President David Brown, P.Eng., chaired the meeting.

**Harry Cayton**, an international advisor who is heading a comprehensive review of PEO's performance as a regulator, spoke at the 524th PEO Council meeting on February 8.

Mr. Cayton said he has had discussions with the Attorney General's office about ways in which the Professional Engineers Act can be improved.

He is conducting interviews with staff, Council, and committees, as well as observing regulatory committees. Mr. Cayton welcomed submissions which can be sent to reviews@harrycayton.net.

He is expected to draft a preliminary report for April, in which PEO will be given an opportunity to fact check. A final report will be submitted to Council in June.

PEO Council also reviewed a recommendation from the Ontario Society of Professional Engineers (OSPE) and Consulting Engineers of Ontario (CEO) to conduct a governance review of PEO.

The motion was tabled pending the receipt of the regulatory review from Mr. Cayton.

#### PEO TASK FORCE PRESENTS FINDINGS ON MAKING LICENSURE 30% FEMALE BY 2030

PEO York Chapter's **Helen Wojcinski**, P.Eng., presented an update on the PEO 30 by 30 task force at the PEO Council meeting on February 7. She highlighted ways to increase female licensure.

Ms. Wojcinski quoted from the action plan, "It is critical that the unacceptably low number of women in the profession be regarded as not just a women-in-engineering issue, but an issue of concern for the entire engineering profession, both women and men."

PEO Council unanimously endorsed the 30 by 30 Initiative in September 2017.

Many other regulatory items were discussed at PEO Council.

## WINDSOR ENGINEER MEETS TWO MINISTERS AT COMMUNITY REGULATORY CONSULTATIONS

(WINDSOR) - Former PEO Government Liaison
Committee member **Andrew Dowie**, P.Eng.,
met two ministers at community consultations
on regulatory issues over the last month in
Windsor.

On January 14, he met Government House
Leader **Todd Smith**, MPP (PC—Bay of Quinte),
who is also the minister of economic development, job creation and trade and government.
Minister Smith was in the Windsor-Essex area
"for a round table discussion to meet with
community stakeholders to discuss regulatory

and other issues on programs administered by the provincial government," said Windsor-Essex GLP Chair **Asif Khan**, P.Eng.

On January 24, Mr. Dowie also met with Children, Community and Social Services minister **Lisa**MacLeod, MPP (PC—Nepean) who is also the minister responsible for women's issues.

Minister MacLeod was "touring the Windsor-Essex area to visit ministry-funded agencies. Mr. Dowie had the opportunity to speak with her," said Mr. Khan.

Mr. Dowie is also a second-term councillor in the town of Tecumseh, an engineer in the city of Windsor, and a former GLP Chair for his chapter.
