Three MPPs spoke at the PEO 2019 East Central and West Central GLP Academy and Congress, which took place at PEO Headquarters on October 5.

PC MPP **Sheref Sabawy** (Mississauga—Erin Mills), NDP Deputy Leader and Housing Critic **Sara Singh**, MPP (Brampton Centre), and NDP Attorney General Critic **Gurratan Singh**, MPP (Brampton East), were guest speakers at the event.

The MPPs discussed how professional engineers can build better relationships with both government and opposition MPPs.

MPP Sabawy has a degree in engineering from Egypt and was an IT professional before being elected to the legislature in 2018. He advised the audience to "stay involved all the time."

MPP Sara Singh spoke about having a meaningful interaction with MPPs, her concerns for internationally educated engineers having their credentials recognized in Canada, and the need to get more women involved in STEM.
