
Each MPP has met with representatives from the Chapter in the past and is familiar with the work of PEO as a regulator.

During MPP Wynne's event, there were several conversations had about trailblazers in politics and other industries. A discussion was had about Canada's first female engineer, **Elsie MacGill**.

In 1938, she became chief aeronautical engineer of Canadian Car & Foundry (Can Car). There, she headed the Canadian production of Hawker Hurricane fighter planes during the Second World War.

MPP Wynne has a long time relationship with PEO and has met with representatives on several occasions. She was the first female Premier of Ontario.


