I am concerned about the future of our profession:

1. For PEO to remain relevant, we must be willing to adopt a governance culture that consistently makes decisions that serve and protect public interests. Self-regulation is a privilege, not a right, and PEO could lose this privilege, similar to the BC and Quebec associations who failed to change.
2. As part of the final phase of governance review, PEO will be evaluating its volunteer structure. PEO must continue to leverage the strength of its license holders to position itself to become a more responsive, progressive regulator.
3. Implement a more stream-lined licensing process to make the progression through licensure less demanding.
