ONTARIO CABINET APPROVES REGULATORY AMENDMENTS FOR CONTINUED PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT



Beginning in January 2023, Ontario engineers will be required to participate in a mandatory continuing professional development (CPD) program to annually maintain their licence. The mandatory CPD program will be based on PEO's current, optional Professional Evaluation and Knowledge (PEAK) program, which was introduced in March 2017. As of January 2023, all PEO licence holders (both practising and nonpractising) will be required to comply with the program to meet their professional obligations to stay current.

ATTORNEY GENERAL SPEAKS AT PEO 100TH ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

A new PEO Council was sworn in at PEO's 100th Annual General Meeting on April 30, including eight new Councillors. The New Democratic Party will remain the official opposition. The Ontario Liberal Party failed to gain official party status. Both party leaders, **Andrea Horwath** and **Steven Del Duca**, respectively, have announced their resignations.


