On September 22, PEO Council held their first bi-monthly meeting of the fall.

PEO COUNCIL MAKES SIGNIFICANT CHANGE TO MANDATORY CPD PROGRAM IN 2024

PEO Council held their 559th meeting on September 22. Most notably, Council approved of a motion to exempt all 13,000 licence and limited licence holders who qualify for fee remission from all annual continuing professional development requirements, effective January 2024.

Council also decided to conduct PEO's 2024 AGM using a hybrid format, which will provide licence holders the opportunity of participating fully either in-person or virtually.

Council approved a significant change to PEO's mandatory CPD program.

As reported on page 1, effective January 1, 2024, all licence and limited licence holders who qualify for fee remission will be exempted from all annual continuing professional development requirements. This exemption will affect approximately 13,000 licence holders who are enrolled in fee remission, 97 per cent of whom have retired from the practice of professional engineering.

PEO's voluntary CPD program was made mandatory for licence holders on January 1, 2023. This change demonstrates PEO's commitment to the continuous improvement of the program, which supports the regulator's legislative mandate to protect the public interest.

Newly appointed Vice-President, Regulatory Operations, **Americo Viola**, P.Eng., MBA, was appointed as Deputy Registrar by Council at the meeting. Council was also advised of the appointment of **Deborah Sikkema** as PEO's Chief People Officer.

OAKVILLE - On September 9, PEO Government Liaison Committee Chair and PEO Oakville chapter's **Jeffrey Lee**, P.Eng., spoke with Parliamentary Assistant to the Minister of Economic Development, Job Creation and Trade **Effie Triantafilopoulos**, MPP (Oakville North-Burlington) at a community event in Oakville.

During the event, MPP Triantafilopoulos announced provincial funding support to Oak Park Neighbourhood Centre in Oakville.

After the announcement, Mr. Lee had an opportunity to speak with MPP Triantafilopoulos and provided a brief update on PEO's initiatives.

PEO Oakville chapter representatives are also planning to visit MPP Triantafilopoulos' constituency office in mid-October to further discuss the latest PEO initiatives, such as the updated professional engineering licencing process and the elimination of Canadian experience as a requirement. The meeting will also serve as an opportunity to introduce the PEO Oakville Chapter GLP Committee members to MPP Triantafilopoulos.

Since MPP Triantafilopoulos was elected in 2018, she has attended numerous PEO Oakville Chapter events, including licencing presentation ceremonies, and has participated in three "Take Your MPP to Work" events over the past five years.
