





Premier **Doug Ford**, MPP (Etobicoke North) was a guest speaker at the 2024 Rural Ontario Municipal Association Conference Annual Conference on January 22 at the Sheraton Centre in Toronto.

The Rural Ontario Municipal Association (ROMA) held their annual conference in Toronto on January 22 and 23. Speakers included Premier **Doug Ford**, MPP (Etobicoke North), Official Opposition Leader and NDP Leader **Marit Stiles**, MPP (Davenport), Liberal Leader **Bonnie Crombie**, and Green Party Leader **Mike Schreiner**, MPP (Guelph). The conference also included a ministerial panel that looked at a number of issues with 28 ministers including Attorney General **Doug Downey**, MPP (Barrie--Springwater--Oro-Medonte) who has responsibility of the PEO file.

PEO Government Relations Consultant **Howard Brown** attended the conference and had a chance to speak with a number of Ministers and MPPs about PEO regulatory issues.

Professional engineering safeguards life, health, property, economic interests, the public welfare and the environment.
