I will continue in advocating for diversity and inclusion and promoting the value of licensure, including initiating the inaugural chapter Women in Engineering Committee. I will pursue other disciplines to join PEO. I will work with chapters by bringing symposium and technical events for chapters. "With respect to the changes in the PEO act (keeping in compliance with FARPACTA legislation), I am concerned about the status of new engineering graduates within Ontario. Since we have lost EIT status, as an elected councillor, I want to work with PEO/ Council to come up with a bridging strategy that will enable engineering graduates to join PEO as trainee engineers, and subsequently become part of the PEO Chapter System for their Professional Development

I would work on reenstate EIT and work on recognizing software and other discipline engineers into the membership.
