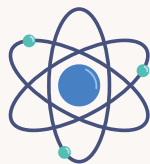
Bridge Building

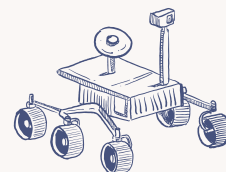
Scholarships
