A brief telephone interview may be scheduled if required. Letters from references are also welcome. The selected recipient will be awarded the PEO Scholarship upon proof of enrolment into an Engineering faculty at an accredited Ontario university. If you have your proof of enrolment at the time of submitting this application form, please submit a copy with this application.
