This PEO Council also oversaw the implementation of the compulsory professional development program (PEAK).

- Two meetings with Ontario Society of Professional Engineers (OSPE) to further build relationships between OSPE and PEO;
- Introduction of a new information packed Volunteer Symposium to replace the traditional Chapter Leaders Conference to allow the inclusion of all PEO volunteers; and
- Comprehensive and Detailed CEO report for Council and other interested parties.

As your Western Regional Councillor, it has been a pleasure to see the organization evolve over the past 4 years and it is my hope that you will vote for me and allow me another 2 years to continue our work and successes.
